

## Instructions for ToolTower Door Mounting

- 1) For best results, check the tower for squareness with a carpenter's square while bolts are being tightened. Loosen and re-tighten the hardware as needed.
- 2) Prior to mounting, carefully peel the protective coverings from a polycarbonate door pane. With the locks in the locked position, lay a door face-down on a non-abrasive surface and carefully slide the pane under the guide rails in the door. As you slide it in, you will need to bend the pane away from the edge of the door so as to avoid scratches. Once the pane is fully inserted, remove the backing from the affixed double-face tape and press the pane firmly onto the tape. Repeat for remaining door(s).
- 3) Remove hardware for middle shelf(s) from face of tower where doors will be mounted.
- 4) There is one magnet for each pair. Making sure the magnet is on the top of the left-hand door, mount doors as shown by reinserting the hardware for the middle shelf(s) and evenly distributing the supplied bolts and locknuts among the remaining holes and slots as shown. Do not tighten yet.
- 5) Align the doors vertically. Align the tower with a carpenter's square.
- 6) While maintaining squareness, tighten all nuts and bolts.
